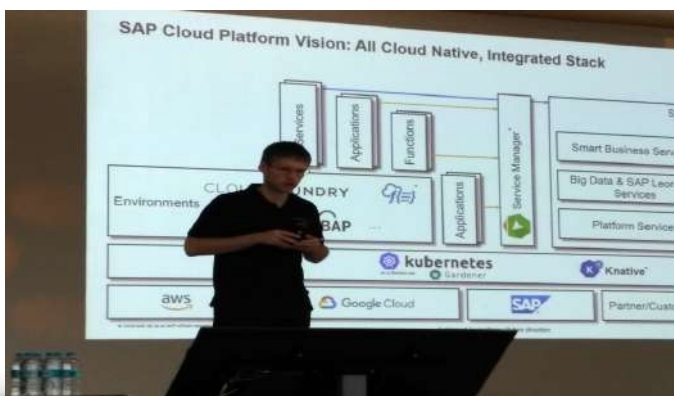

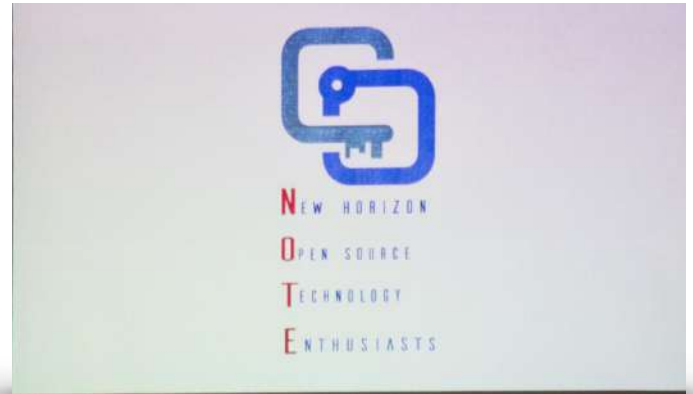

All the students who attended were quite interested with the interactive session by the Chief Guest Naveen Mudunuru.

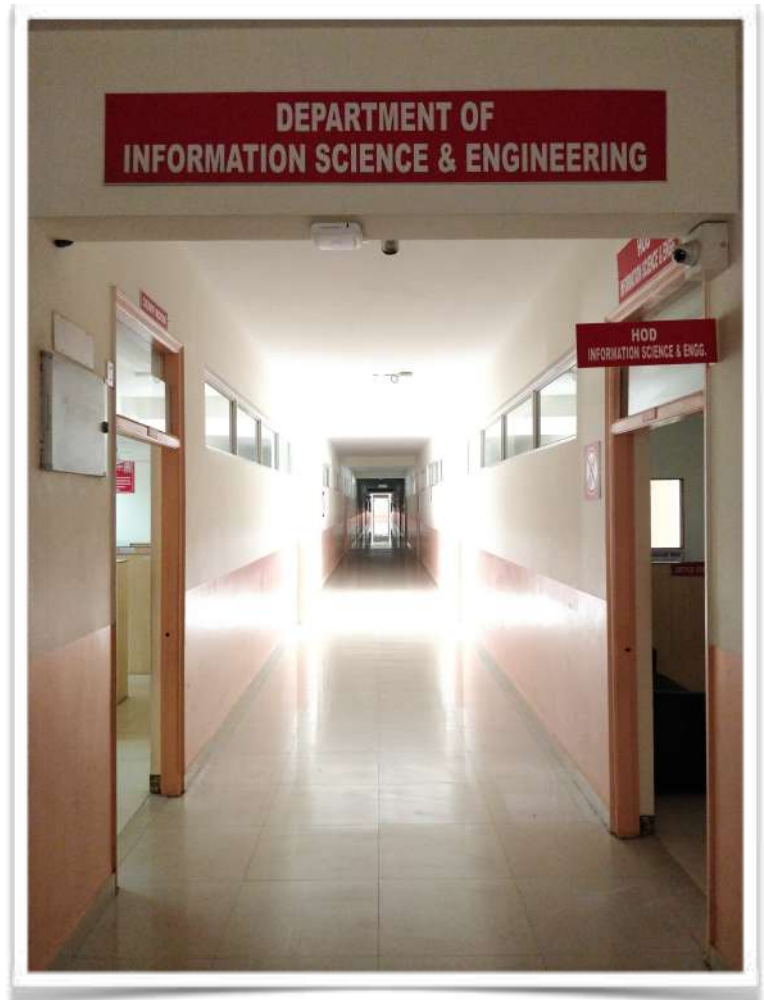
ABOUT DEPARTMENT
