BOS members were provided with proposed Scheme and syllabus book of UG& PG and stationery items required for effective discussion and conduction.

TITLE

Highlights of the Department-Introduction

- 1 HoDstarted the presentation by highlighting the College accreditations details, NIRF ranking with members.
- 2 Salient features of the teaching learning process in Information Science and Engineering department like project oriented learning through mini project,20% of syllabus being covered by industry expert, training through center of excellence ,VMware lab were highlighted.
- 3 BOS members appreciated the achievements and initiatives taken by the department.

TITLE

Scheme and Syllabus for 2018-2022Batch (175 credits scheme) – Discussion Recommendation and Approval.

Minutes

Salient features as below were highlighted by the BOS chairman:

- 1. The scheme is framed in such a way to handle three career options for the information science and engineering students:
 - 1. Data science Engineer 2. Networking Engineer 3. Software developer
- 2. Increased credit weightage to Practical oriented learning.
- 3. Credit based MOOC Courses-NPTEL/SWAYAM.
- 4. Project based learning through Mini project in all semesters
- 5. Semester wise scheme was presented to the Board of studies, following are the suggestion and recommendations:-

3rd Semester:

- Dr.Natarajan recommended to retain self study component
- Mr.Deva suggested to implement Data structures using python or higher level language, but Mr.AnisMirza,proposed that Data structures with C can be retained as it is needed for placement.
- All the board members suggested to have OOPs with java instead of OOPS with C++.

4th Semester:

- Dr.Natarajan recommended that Discrete methematics and Graph theory to be preferably taught by ISE faculty.
- Board members suggested to remove the course Programming in Java as the course was augmented with OOPS in 3rd semester.
- For DBMS course Dr.Varaprasad suggested to add NOSQL, for which the chairman said we have proposed it as an elective.
- Board Members appreciated the concept of Miniproject in each semester.

5th Semester:

- Board members suggested that Data Sciences using R can be done using Python and Data analytics course as an elective. Chairman said that it is already available in professional elective group 5.
- Mr.Mohan, Practice head- Wipro, strongly recommended to have lab for IoT course and also agreed to have industry interaction from WIPRO for the

same.BOS chairman extended her gratitude and said that department will follow up and sign a MOU for this technical knowledge.

• BOS members suggested the following corrections in the scheme;

 $\begin{array}{l} \text{IoT} \quad : \text{from 5}^{\text{th}} \text{sem to 4}^{\text{rd}} \text{sem} \\ \text{OOPs: from 3}^{\text{rd}} \text{sem to 4}^{\text{th}} \text{sem} \\ \end{array}$

OS : from 4thsem to 5thsem

• It was suggested that Application Development course can be offered as elective instead of Core.

6th Semester:

- Application Development lab is redundant and can be offered to have as a mini project.
- For the course Data mining and Machine Learning, it was suggested to have data mining and keep only machine learning.
- Text books for machine learning should be changed to latest version and also syllabus has to be refined.
- For the course Computer networks Lab, it was suggested to write the code for creating simulation instead of simple drag and drop.

7th Semester:

• Board members suggested to remove Statistical lab with Excel

8th semester:

BOS chairman highlighted the tool usage in carrying out the Internship during semester and proposed to have it during summer breaks right from 4^{th} sem and viva for the same will be in 8^{th} sem.

Professional Elective:

- Streamwise clustering of electives was suggested
- Recommended to keep cloud computing and Software Engineering as a core subject
- The following courses were suggested to be removed from elective list committee agreed upon the same:
 - 1.FAFL
 - 2.ITC
 - 3. Compiler design

BOS Meeting – Department of Information Science and Engineering

- Information retrieval and Multimedia courses can be added for elective.
- 6. DrSundeep(VTU Representative) suggested that File Structures is must needed course and recommended to introduce it in 6th semester .Other committee members agreed for the same.
