



A REPORT ON COMMUNITY SERVICE

On the morning of 21st August 2025, the NCC and NSS cadets of New Horizon College of Engineering assembled at the college campus and boarded the college bus, accompanied by NCC Officer, Mr. Ravikumar and Transport Manager, Mr. Velu. With great enthusiasm and a sense of responsibility, the journey began towards Bandipur, where the community service program was scheduled.

The NCC and NSS members volunteered for one day of Community Service to assist with the following programs:

1. Handing over newly built houses to the villagers.
2. Laying the foundation stone for the construction of a temple in the village, envisioned to serve as a spiritual center.
3. Distributing essential commodities such as food, clothing, and daily necessities.

The initiative aimed to ensure that every individual, whether adult or child, could live with dignity and have access to essential needs and facilities.

1. Empowering Tribal Communities with Safe Housing

As part of this initiative, the NHEI Management handed over newly built houses to the villagers, providing them with safe and permanent shelter. This marked a significant milestone in uplifting the living standards of the local tribal families, many of whom previously lived in vulnerable conditions. The overwhelming joy and gratitude expressed by the villagers created a truly heart-warming atmosphere.

2. Temple Foundation Stone Laying Ceremony

Upon reaching the village by noon, the team was warmly welcomed by the village volunteer group. The program commenced with the foundation stone laying ceremony for the new temple, followed by an insightful speech delivered by a community representative. The address highlighted the cultural and social values of the village, underlining the importance of preserving tradition while fostering progress.

3. Donation and Cleanliness Drive

Essential commodities like food, clothing, and daily-use items were distributed to all households of the village. Following the donation drive, the cadets actively participated in a cleanliness activity, collecting and disposing of plastic waste in and around the village. This initiative promoted environmental awareness and contributed to

building a cleaner and healthier environment. The activity also instilled in students the importance of sustainable practices in community service.

4. Motivational Session

The program concluded with a motivational speech by Shri Surya Narayan, Member of the *Vishwa Hindu Parishad*. He spoke about the challenges faced by the tribal community and emphasized the importance of student participation in service-oriented initiatives. His words inspired the cadets to extend their commitment to social responsibility beyond this camp.
